# **GO-TO CULINARY MYSTERY AUTHORS**

Recipe from Diane Mott Davidson's book Killer Pancake from the Goldy Shultz series.

#### Killer Pancakes

2 cups all-purpose flour

1 cup sugar

1 teaspoon baking soda

1/2 teaspoon salt

2 egg whites

116-ounce can juice-packed fruit cocktail, drained and juice reserved

Maple syrup or chopped fresh strawberries macerated with a little sugar

Preheat the oven to 350. Spray 2 nonstick cookie sheets with vegetable oil and set aside.

Sift the dry ingredients together and set aside. Beat the egg whites until frothy. Beat in the juice. Gradually add the dry mixture, stirring until well blended. Fold in the fruit cocktail.

Using an 1/8-cup (2 tablespoon) measure, scoop dollops of pancake batter onto the sprayed pans, leaving at least 2 inches between the pancakes. Bake for 10 to 15 minutes or until puffed and golden. Serve hot with maple syrup, fresh strawberries, peaches, or other fruit.



## **Dewberry Farm Cozy Mysteries**


