In June 2010, the West Linn Library Foundation received tax-exempt status from the Internal Revenue Service and began active fundraising. Concurrently, the Foundation Board put in place all that is necessary for governance of a non-profit organization. Achievements of the Foundation, as of 6/30/2011 include the following:

- Board adopted **vision, mission, and goals**.
 - Vision: *Expand our library's capacity to engage, connect, and inspire.*
 - Mission: *Generate support for the West Linn Public Library through raising funds and other gifts.*
 - Goals: *Promote the appreciation for the West Linn Public Library. Raise funds for library collections, programs, and facilities.*
- Foundation complied with **laws and policies**, including West Linn Library Foundation Bylaws and Financial Management Policy, Internal Revenue Service, Oregon Department of Justice, and Oregon Secretary of State.
- Foundation built **partnerships** with the Oregon Cultural Trust, Friends of the West Linn Public Library and the West Linn Public Library Advisory Board.
- Board **reached out to the community** through the West Linn Public Library website, at library programs and events, and through news media.
- Foundation **raised funds, services, and goods** and funded new equipment for the library teen program. In-kind donations helped with Foundation operations
