February 23, 2016 Marylhurst Neighborhood Minutes REVISED

- 1. President Oakes called meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Two officers, five members and one guest in attendance. Quorum of six met.
- 2. Ms. Cummings moved to approve agenda as written and the January 26, 2016 mintutes, second by Mr. Morrison and approved by voice vote with none opposed.
- 3. Secretary Cummings stated that Treasurer Boucher reports no new transactions since the last meeting. Ms. Boucher and former Treasurer Wilson are taking steps to transfer treasurer's duty.
- 4. Ms. Oakes reported that Ms. Burke attended a transportation advisory board meeting to present MNA's eight traffic safety concerns. The results of City's recent study of Suncrest and Valley View intersection area are pending. Lance Calvert, West Linn's head of engineering has offered to attend a future MNA meeting. A member asked, "How do people get out of here if Suncrest is blocked and Marylhurst DR or Skye Parkway is too icy?" Another member who described having a similar experience, inquired about the status of Kapteyns Street. Pres. Oakes said she has not heard about any potential changes. Members briefly discussed the reasons why Kapteyns St. is closed. Jason Miller described his family's safety concerns related to heavy fast moving traffic on the narrow section of Valley View where they live. Mr. Miller moved, with a second by Mr. Neff, to request City to enforce "Local Access Only" signage on Valley View DR. and send a flyer to educate Marylhurst and Skye Parkway residents about the need to use Hillcrest instead. Discussion included a history of past efforts to address the problem. All agreed that the situation has only been getting worse. It is not known whether making it a one-way street would help. Motion approved with none opposed
