Backyard Habitat Program Presentation, Anya Pickard

Participants are provided technical support and incentive to eliminate invasive weeds, grow native plants, reduce/eliminate pesticides, manage sormwater sustainably and be good wildlife stewards. There are three levels of certification to give participants options and it cost \$35.

It was moved and seconded to certify the Labyrinth at Marylhurst Heights Park. Members felt it would be a first step for participation in the neighborhood and also be a good visual promoter. The motion carried 11-0-0.

Citizen Perspective

President Oakes provided a brief overview and asked for input. It was generally appreciated. One member thought the site review process could really be better. Oakes explained that the CCI honsidered the Citizen Perspective in its work to improve the land-use process.

Election of Officers

Marylhurst Heights Park Maintenance

Members have observed the walking path is overrun with roses and impassable, causing people to walk on the turf and damaging it. Also of concern are invasives in the swale. A letter will be sent to the City requesting maintenance.

Members agreed to cancel the November and December meetings due to holidays.
