- Call to Order Jef Treece, MNA President spoke about ways that the City of West Linn communicates with residents. People who do not use the internet can request to be notified by mail of upcoming meetings. Parliamentary Procedure is used for meetings and a quorum for MNA is 8 residents.

Marylhurst Heights Park – The earliest time for developing additional parking and widening of Valley View Drive would begin in 2015.

Land Use – Karie Oakes attended a Pre Application meeting about property adjoining Marylhurst NA, in Skyline Parkway requesting more than a 2 foot variance setback for a single home. Testimony is still being collected.

Resolution on "Cut the Red Tape" – Jef sent this document to the city. A motion was made by Karie Oakes to change the wording to "unopposed ." A vote was taken and the motion failed. The next Planning Commission meeting is scheduled for the evening of Oct. 2, 2013. NAP – Jef reported on the goals of the Neighborhood Association of Presidents, which has been meeting for 2 or 3 years with the purpose, "strategic, with some emphasis on tactical goals and processes." Teri Cummings would like to include this topic on the agenda at the October MNA meeting and requested that two documents be distributed to residents before the next meeting.

Election of Officers – will be held at the October 26th meeting. Nominations are open until the voting takes place. Residents can nominate someone else or themselves for the positions of: President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer. Voting will be by written ballot.
