Meeting purpose: planning (April meeting was decision making)

Clarification discussion: NA vs HOA

Review - in recent meetings, we:

- determined that quorum is 4
- minimum requirements for active NA is
 1. an annual budget meeting
 2. an election meeting, per your by-laws
 3. at least two meetings per year
 4. these requirement meetings meet Oregon Public Meeting Law standards
 5. a board of at least three members
- decided how to recommend split of stipend among NAs

Brainstorm session gave us the immediate things we think we should work on. Sub-bullets are brainstorm ideas, not conclusive actions:

Communication – five votes

- This group: standardize NAP emails to all neighborhood associations
- Improve city's neighborhood website (repository)
- Set up web page for us to store our documents
- SNA and other NA westlinn.gov email accounts
- Standardize communication template to our neighborhood, i.e mailchimp
- Joint website – blog? Connecting neighborhoods
- Assign city website to NA Board

Advisory Role – five votes

- Improve planning process/interaction for NA timely input
- Strengthen rapport/working relationship w/ council and staff
- NAP members connect w/ various advisory groups 1-member per
- Street improvement, sidewalk improvement
- Recognition through city as advisory group
- Recognize NAs as grass-roots connection to citizenry

Governance – five votes

- Agree upon common “core” by-laws/functions/purpose
- Decide whether or not to have standard by-laws

Finance – three votes

- For next budget ask for double the amount of stipend
- Do a budget exercise to see if we have enough \$\$
- Improve NA overall funding

Leadership – two votes

- Determine our own operational procedures
- Training on NA leadership and communication conferences
- Find our next leader
- Support each other at the NA level

Reporting – no votes

- Reduce # of NAs
- Hear more info/reports from each others' NAs
- Present status to CC

Procedures – no votes

- Own copy of City Codes for use for any decision making process
