Check in and Registration: All parade entrants must report in front of Handris Realty Company between 8:00am and 9:00am to receive parade day instructions.

Entry Rules: All entries should try to reflect the parade theme. The parade is not a forum for overt commercialization. Political and religious entries are welcome, but entrants are reminded that the parade is for the enjoyment, not education, of the viewers. Printed literature is not to be distributed as it causes a litter problem. Tossing of candy from car or float is discouraged. We do not want children running into the streets in front of cars. Candy may be tossed by people walking next to the float or car.

All applicants must sign a Waiver on page three of the entry form.

All drivers must hold a valid driver's license and each vehicle must have a full tank of gas.

All entries with horses shall load and unload the animals in the designated area. A map will be available at the registration table.

All equestrian entries must be accompanied by an adult at all times and provide a "scooper."

Judging is by volunteers, not professionals. The criteria each judge uses is based on their likes and opinions.
