- 1) Confirmed that we had a quorum**
- 2) Minutes from the April 1st 2026 meeting were unanimously approved**
- 3) Treasurers report – confirmed that funds will be available within a period of 2 months. These funds are contributed to the NA's by West Linn. The amount available will be approx. \$12,000**
- 4) The subject of a donation to the West Linn Food Bank was discussed. There seems to be general agreement to making the donation once we have access to the funds**
- 5) Discussed whether we should adopt Zoom for future meetings. A review will be made of the costs involved.**
- 6) Future meetings – discussions on the number of future meetings to be held annually. It was agreed that we should hold quarterly meetings. There are a number of subject to be discussed in future**

meetings. It was agreed that we should look at August 5th for our next meeting.

7) Discussions on future activities to be coordinated by PCNA. One of the other NA's has a Summer Picnic for their residents

8) There were two proposals made by the Treasurer
Proposals were-

a) I move that the PCNA membership direct the board of directors to prepare a preliminary budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1 2026.

b) I move that the PCNA membership authorize the board of directors (Brigitte Howley, Jim Nixon, Ray Hone and Barry Rogge) to be added to the PCNA debit card and given access and use of the PCNA debit Card for that account.

Both were unanimously adopted.

9) Barry Rogge thanked Joe and Brigitte Howley for coordinating the new PCNA.

10)The group discussed items for future discussion at the Association meetings –

a. The most popular was the Land Development currently taking place in the Parker Crest area. The Developer is going to be invited to the next meeting so we can hear and discuss their plans for the development.
