PUBLIC HEARING – MISCELLANEOUS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CODE AMENDMENTS, CDC-16-01

Chair Babbitt explained the Planning Commission's role in the legislative process is to make a recommendation to City Council, who will hold their own public hearing at a later date. He then provided an outline of how the meeting will proceed: after the preliminary legal matters, staff will make a presentation, the commission will have an opportunity to ask questions of staff, followed by public testimony. After the commission has a final chance to ask questions, the hearing will be closed and the commission will discuss the proposal and make a recommendation.

Ms. Thornton provided the preliminary legal matters.

The hearing commenced with a staff presentation by Mr. Boyd. There are four core changes being considered 1) Office Business Center zoning and the use of the first floor, 2) Planned Unit Development requirements, including a new three acre minimum standard, 3) Water Resource Area Protection, referencing the METRO Urban Growth Management Function Plan and considering new exempt uses, and 4) Removing requirements for easements and dedications in Water Resource Areas, Greenways, and tree protection areas. This would also include changes to the CDC definitions.

Ann Miller, Roxanna Khosravi, Doris Clark, Tom Farwell and Myron Wallace spoke.

The Planning Commission moved into deliberations.

Commissioner Jim Farrell **moved** to continue the public hearing to June 15, 2016, leaving the written record open until 5:00 p.m. on June 14, 2016.

Commissioner Gary Walvatne **seconded** the motion.
