# PUBLIC HEARING – CONTINUED FROM MAY 17, 2017: 6-LOT SUBDIVISION AT 4096 CORNWALL STREET SUB-17-01/WRG-17-01 (STAFF: JENNIFER ARNOLD)

Chair Walvatne reminded everyone that this is a quasi-judicial hearing and that the decision must be grounded in the relevant code. If the application meets the code, the commission must approve it. He then provided an outline of how the meeting will proceed. After the preliminary legal matters, staff will make a short presentation, followed by public testimony. The applicant will then have time for rebuttal.

Mr. Ramis provided the preliminary legal matters.

Jennifer Arnold, Associate Planner provided an update since the last meeting regarding the conditions of approval. One condition has been revised and one condition has been added.

Lance Calvert, Public Works Director explained the process for road reconstruction in West Linn and answered street, stormwater and utility questions posed by the commissioners.

Mike Robinson, Rick Givens, Bruce Goldson and Mike Ard provided rebuttal for the applicant.

After considerable questioning of staff and the applicant's consultants, Chair Walvatne suggested deliberations occur during the next Planning Commission meeting on June 21.
