Subject: Agenda Item 5: Discussion and Comments Regarding HB 2001/2003

The West Linn City Council recently discussed the rulemaking process for House Bill 2001 (HB2001)/House Bill 2003 (HB2003) and requested the Committee for Citizen Involvement (CCI) discuss the status and rulemaking for HB 2001/2003 and provide comment. Information regarding the rulemaking process is attached. City Council would like comments back to them by September, which leaves the CCI with the July and August meetings to discuss this topic.

In addition, it will be a good opportunity for the CCI to also discuss how the citizens of West Linn will be able to engage in the process for meeting the requirements of HB2001/2003. What types of engagement tools are appropriate: open houses, online survey(s), informative flyers, etc?
