1. Call to Order

Vice-Chair Schreiber called the virtual meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

2. Public Comment Related To Land Use Items Not On the Agenda

New City Manager Jerry Gabrielatos introduced himself to the Board.

3. Approval of Meeting Notes: June 16, 2020 and July 21, 2020

5. Review Letter to City Council - Historic City Hall National Register Application

The Board provided feedback on the draft letter of support to the City Council for Historic City Hall placement of the National Historic Register. Board members asked that the letter be submitted to the City Council at their next meeting. Acting Planning Manager noted that staff is preparing a timeline to submit a nomination application for the March 1, 2021 deadline.

Board Member Young asked that the HRB discuss historic design review code at future meetings. Vice -Chair asked to add the grant cycle to the agenda in February. Acting Planning Manager identified Chapter 25 Code review and CLG grants as agenda items for the upcoming HRB meetings.

Vice Chair Schreiber noted that the Historical Society does an annual Living History Tour in September. In the past, the City has provided grants for the Tour.
