1. Call to Order

3. Recommendation: Housing Production Strategy Project Working Group

The meeting focused on the housing production strategy project and forming a working group, discussing potential members, public engagement strategies through social media and physical marketing materials, utilizing neighborhood association groups, and upcoming projects such as revisiting the Hillsboro Engagement Plan and engaging with the community at events.

Planning Manager Darren Wyss discussed the proposed members for the working group, with some positions still to be filled. The group is expected to start meeting in early June. Members reviewed the Working Group's purpose and goals.

Members discussed the Parks and Rec Community Recreation Center Feasibility Study. Knight aimed to ensure the public was thoroughly engaged in the feasibility study. Members discussed developing a plan for increasing public engagement and awareness of the parks and recreation center project, including distributing pamphlets and utilizing local businesses and social media platforms. Members wanted to follow up with Doug Erickson regarding the role of communications and their involvement in promoting the project.

Members discussed getting involved in the Wednesday markets.

Wyss discussed the possibility of creating an engagement plan and seeking funding from the City Council to hire a consultant for assistance.
