Work Session #1 Recap - April 3, 2024

- Appellant should state at least one code criteria that is being met/applied
- 'de-novo with focus' was mentioned; Lack of appellant specifics of the issue doesn't allow proper preparation by all parties involved.
- More info on neighboring jurisdictions process is desired.

♦ Work Session #2 Recap – June 5, 2024

- Appellant specificity of issue/concerns should be required; Staff, applicant, public, and others cannot prepare properly without knowing the appeal argument.
- Maintain current de-novo language
- Karie Oakes spoke in favor of keeping a de-novo style hearing. Believes the appellant should not be required to provide specificity when filing appeal;
