

PLANNING COMMISSION Meeting Notes of August 7, 2024

1. Call To Order and Roll Call

Vice Chair Metlen called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. Planning Manager Wyss took roll.

2. Public Comment related to Items not on the Agenda None.

3. Approval of Meeting Notes: 07.17.2024

Commissioner Walvatne moved to approve the meeting notes for 07.17.2024. Jones seconded. Ayes: Metlen, Jones, Walvatne, and Watton. Nays: None. Abstentions: None. The motion passed 4-0-0.

4. Work Session: 2024 Code Process Amendments Work Session #4

Commissioners discussed finalizing draft code amendments for extensions of approval, appeals process, and home occupations. The proposed code amendments include the following changes:

- Across three work sessions on April 3, June 5, and July 17, 2024, the PC requested a formal
 verification of the Planning Manager's authority when the Planning Director's position is vacant. In
 response, staff provided City Manager John Williams a letter confirming the Planning Manager's
 authority during such vacancies.
- PC specifically requested the removal of the word "detailed" from the proposed code for appeal of development decisions. The final draft code reflects this change.
- Additionally, the PC requested that the code allow a maximum of 12 vehicle trips for home occupations involving pupils or students.
- New definitions for "Middle Housing" and "Middle Housing Land Division" have been added.
- Submittal requirements have been added for expedited and middle housing land divisions to ensure complete applications.
- All expedited land divisions would be a staff-level decision.
- Section 99.060(E) now includes the Land Use Referee's approval authority for appeals related to ELDs and MHLDs.
