Subject: Draft Tech Memo 11: Planned and Financially Constrained Transportation System

Please find Draft Tech Memo 11, Planned and Financially Constrained Transportation System, for your review and comment. Draft Tech Memo 11 will be presented for discussion at the next Planning Commission meeting to be held May 13th at 6:00 at the Police Station conference room located at 1800 8th Avenue.

Draft Tech Memo 11 lists projects and programs recommended to address the city's transportation needs. The listed projects and programs have been ranked high, medium, or low priority relative to each other using evaluation criteria which have been reviewed and revised based on Citizen Advisory Committee (CAC) and Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) comments. The revised evaluation criteria are shown in Attachment "A" and the evaluation of each project and program is shown in Attachment "B". The forecasted funding is approximately \$50,000,000 over the next 25-years (see Tech Memo 4, Forecast Funding and Local Funding Sources) which is projected to fund the recommended high priority projects only.

The evaluation and ranking should be viewed as tool and not as an absolute in determining the city's priority investments and actions and we look forward to receiving your feedback on the draft priorities. On May 7th we will be soliciting feedback on the draft priorities from the CAC. Following the Planning Commission review on May 13th, comments from the City Council will also be sought on May 18th for potential revisions to the priority of the projects and programs. In late summer, additional public input will be sought on the priority projects and programs as part of the Public Review Draft Transportation System Plan.

Your input is essential and greatly appreciated. I look forward to seeing you on May 13th.
