West Linn Project Advisory Committee HB2001/2003 – Phase 1

<u>Purpose</u>

The City has commenced work on HB2001 and HB2003 and will treat both as two-phased projects. Phase 1 will be a technical exercise, which entails producing a Housing Needs Analysis (HB2003) and identifying code amendments (HB2001) necessary to comply with state rules. Phase 2 will be policy decisions and the legislative adoption process with the Planning Commission and City Council. The policy decisions will focus on whether the City does the minimum necessary to comply with state rules or goes further to promote/encourage the development of needed housing in the community.

To complete Phase 1, the City secured grant funding from the Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD) to conduct the technical analysis that will lead to recommendations on actions the City will need to take to meet the state requirements. Angelo Planning will lead the consultant team working with the City on HB2003 and MIG, Inc. will be the lead consultant on HB2001. Both grant funded projects will be complete by end of June 2021.

The West Linn City Council appointed a limited-duration Project Advisory Committee. The purpose and role of the Project Advisory Committee is to review the Phase 1 consultant work products and provide feedback. The members of the committee were chosen because of their housing knowledge, familiarity with HB 2001 and HB2003, or their involvement with City policy making.

The committee is scheduled to meet three times during Phase 1 (Dec. 2020, Feb. 2021, and April 2021). As a project-specific committee, the expectation is the committee's expertise will help the consultant teams to provide the City with the best information to ensure compliance with the two house bills. Additionally, the committee's feedback will be useful to staff in Phase 2 conversations with the community.
