Dear Peter:

In response to your letter of dated Dec. 22, 2016 we are submitting the following:

85.160(E) (1) The Tentative Plan has been modified to clearly identify the location and widths for the existing street and rights-of-way. The Preliminary Utility Plan shows proposed street improvements, new water services, sanitary sewer, and storm drainage and rain garden locations.

85.160 (E) (5) We retained Multnomah Tree Experts to tag the trees on the site. Mike Perkins subsequently visited the site and determined that there are no significant trees, tree clusters or heritage trees on the property. The Tentative Plan is noted accordingly. There is a large black walnut tree off-site to the east. We have depicted the location of the drip line of that tree on the Tentative Plan drawing. We will agree not to build within the depicted drip line on Parcel 3.

85.160 (E) (7) The Preliminary Utility Plan identifies the size and location of existing sewers, water mains, culverts, drain pipes, gas, electric, and other utility lines within the site, and in the adjoining streets and property.

85.160 (F) (2) The Preliminary Utility Plan shows the type, method, and location of any erosion prevention and sediment control measures and/or facilities in accordance with the most current version of Clackamas County's Erosion/Sedimentation Control Plans Technical Guidance Handbook.

85.160 (F) (7) The Tentative Plan shows the location of two street trees to be planted along the frontage of Parcel 1. This plan was reviewed and approved by Mike Perkins.

85.170 (A) (7) A table showing density calculations for the maximum allowable number of lots is shown on the Tentative Plan.

85.170 (A) (8) All slopes on the subject property are less than 15% grade. This is noted on the Tentative Plan.






