#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The applicant requests a temporary use permit for a fireworks stand in the west portion of the Safeway parking lot at 22000 Salamo Rd. The applicant will utilize a 20 ft. by 40 ft. tent and operate the stand daily from 8:00am to 11:00pm. The requested permit is to operate the stand for 14 days (June 23 to July 6, 2017). Temporary uses for up to 120 days with extensions may be approved by the Planning Manager per 99.060.A.1(a). The site has been used for this temporary use in each of the past 20 years.

The placement of the temporary use meets the dimensional standards, setbacks, lot coverage and other provisions of the underlying General Commercial zone.

#### **DECISION**

The Planning Manager (designee) approves this application (MIS-17-02), based on: 1) the findings submitted by the applicant, which are incorporated by this reference, 2) supplementary staff findings included in the Addendum below. With these findings, the applicable approval criteria are met.

The provisions of the Community Development Code Chapter 99 have been met.

DATE

Appeals to this decision must be filed with the West Linn Planning Department within 14 days of mailing date. Cost is \$400. An appeal to City Council of a decision by the Planning Manager shall be heard on the record. The appeal must be filed by an individual who has established standing by submitting comments prior to the decision date. Approval will lapse 3 years from effective approval date if the final plat is not recorded.

Therefore, the 14-day appeal period ends at 5 p.m., on April 19, 2017.

Note to Applicant: The temporary use must cease and be removed from the property by July 7, 2017.

# ADDENDUM APPROVAL CRITERIA AND FINDINGS MIS-17-02

This decision adopts the findings for approval contained within the applicant's submittal, with the following exceptions and additions:

Chapter 19
GENERAL COMMERCIAL, GC

19.050 USES AND DEVELOPMENT PERMITTED UNDER PRESCRIBED CONDITIONS

The following uses are allowed in this zone under prescribed conditions:

5. Temporary use, subject to the provisions of Chapter <u>35</u> CDC.

Staff Finding 1: This use is permitted in that the applicant has applied for a temporary use permit under the provisions of CDC Chapter 35.

19.070 DIMENSIONAL REQUIREMENTS, USES PERMITTED OUTRIGHT AND USES PERMITTED UNDER PRESCRIBED CONDITIONS

- A. Except as may be otherwise provided by the provisions of this code, the following are the requirements for uses within this zone:
- 1. The minimum front lot line length or the minimum lot width at the front lot line shall be 35 feet.
- 2. The average minimum lot width shall be 50 feet.
- 3. The average minimum lot depth shall not be less than 90 feet.

(...)

- 5. The maximum lot coverage shall be 50 percent, except as provided in CDC  $\underline{58.090}(C)(1)(d)$ .
- 6. The maximum building height shall be two and one-half stories or 35 feet for any structure located within 50 feet of a low or medium density residential zone, and three and one-half stories or 45 feet for any structure located 50 feet or more from a low or medium density residential zone.
- 7. For lot lines that abut an arterial, there shall be no minimum yard dimensions or minimum building setback area, and the maximum building setback shall be 20 feet. The front setback area between the street and the building line shall consist of landscaping or a combination of non-vehicular hardscape areas (covered with impervious surfaces) and landscaped areas. If there are not street trees within the public right-of-way, the front setback area shall include such trees per the requirements of the City Arborist.

Staff Finding 2: The parent property, owned by Albertsons, exceeds the required dimensional standards. The maximum 50 percent lot coverage is not compromised by a 20' X 40' temporary tent. The landscaping transitions and setbacks along Salamo Road are already met by the existing development's setbacks and landscaping.

#### 35.030 TEMPORARY USE STANDARDS

- A. Temporary uses shall be approved if they meet the following standards:
- 1. Sites accommodating a temporary use shall be appropriate for the proposed use, as determined by the approval authority with consideration of the following:
- a. The proposed site shall have adequate parking and circulation space consistent with Chapter 46 CDC, Off-Street Parking, Loading and Reservoir Areas; safe ingress and egress consistent with Chapter 48 CDC, Access, Egress and Circulation; and adequate line of sight and vision clearance per Chapter 42 CDC, Clear Vision Areas.

Staff Finding 3: The parking lot and circulation areas comprise 93,500 square feet and includes 240 parking spaces. Staff finds that this area is large enough for safe ingress/egress and vehicular circulation. There is also sufficient parking for the temporary use. Staff finds that many of the temporary use's customers will be shopping at other stores in this shopping center so a reduction in total parking demand by cross-patronage is expected per 46.080(A). The temporary use's proposed location will not compromise the lines of sight or clear vision areas.

b. The proposed site shall have a paved or graveled surface sufficient to avoid dust generation and mud tracking from anticipated traffic or erosion control measures, consistent with Clackamas County Erosion Prevention and Sediment Control Planning and Design Manual, rev. 2008, and shall be used to keep any mud, sediment and dust on site.

#### Staff Finding 4: The parking lot is already paved.

c. The proposed use shall conform to all applicable requirements of Chapter <u>27</u> CDC, Flood Management Areas; Chapter <u>28</u> CDC, Willamette and Tualatin River Protection; Chapter <u>32</u> CDC, Water Resource Area Protection; and other City regulations.

Staff Finding 5: The proposed use is not in a flood management area, within the Willamette or Tualatin River Protection Area, or within a Water Resource Area, environmental zone or hazard area. Therefore this criterion does not apply.

d. The proposed temporary use shall not be materially detrimental to the public welfare, or injurious to the property or improvements in the immediate vicinity.

Staff Finding 6: The State Fire Marshall and TVFR have already approved the temporary use. On that basis, the use is not expected to be detrimental to public welfare or injurious to the property.

2. The approval authority may require that structures and trailers allowed as temporary uses for more than 60 days be screened from the view of occupants of any abutting residential and commercial structures, consistent with Chapter 44 CDC, unless the applicant demonstrates that such screening is not needed.

## Staff Finding 7: The temporary use is housed within a tent. There is no need for screening of this use.

3. Drop boxes, trailers, or structures that serve a similar function are allowed, consistent with subsection A of this section, for registered nonprofit, religious or benevolent groups, orders or associations, when they are proposed to be located in General Commercial, Office Business Center, Campus Industrial, General Industrial, or Neighborhood Commercial districts.

Drop boxes and structures serving a similar function, not including trailers, shall not exceed seven feet in height or have a footprint of more than 25 square feet on a single site. Their color shall be limited to earth tones.

Staff Finding 8: No drop boxes are proposed so this criterion does not apply.

4. The property owner has authorized the proposed temporary use in writing.

Staff Finding 9: The owner has authorized and signed the application form.

#### MASTER FIREWORKS AGREEMENT

THIS MASTER FIREWORKS AGREEMENT (this "Master Agreement") is dated as of March 117, 2016, and is entered into by and between Albertsons Companies LLC, a Delaware limited liability company ("Albertsons") on behalf of itself and its subsidiaries and American Promotional Events, Inc. - West, a California Corporation, dba TNT Fireworks ("TNT").

#### RECITALS:

- A. Albertsons. Albertsons through the Companies operates grocery supermarkets in the United States.
- B. TNT. TNT desires to enter upon a portion of the parking lot of some of the Stores for the sole purpose of selling fireworks on and around the 4<sup>th</sup> of July and New Year's Eve holidays.

#### AGREEMENT.

Now, therefore, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

#### 1 Definitions.

1.1 Definitions. When used in this Master Agreement, the following terms shall have the meanings set forth below.

"Company" shall mean each of Albertsons LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, New Albertson's Inc., an Ohio corporation, Safeway Inc., a Delaware corporation, The Vons Companies, Inc., a Michigan corporation, and Randall's Food and Drugs Market, LP, a Delaware limited partnership (collectively "Companies").

"Confidential Information" is defined in Section 7.

"Event' shall mean a single holiday fireworks sale occasion in connection with the 4<sup>th</sup> of July or New Year's Eve. In that regard a single Store may be the location of two (2) Events in a single year.

"Fireworks Wholesale Sales" is defined in Section 4.2.

"Individual Vendor" shall mean those nonprofit organizations or other entities which contract with TNT to operate a fireworks stand on the License Premises.

"License" shall mean the right to install and operate a fireworks stand in the area of the parking lots of the Stores pursuant the Revocable License Agreement, the form of which is attached as Exhibit A. "License Premises" shall mean the area of the parking lots licensed under the Revocable License Agreement for the placement of the fireworks stands.

"Store" shall mean a grocery supermarket operated by any Company.

#### 2 Term.

2.1 Term of Master Agreement. The term of this Master Agreement shall commence on the date of this Master Agreement as indicated above (the "Effective Date") and shall expire on September 15, 2018. There are no option terms to extend this Master Agreement.

#### 3 Agreement To Install Fireworks Stands.

3.1 Agreement To Install Fireworks Stands in Identified Stores. Albertsons has provided (and will provide form time to time) TNT with a list of Stores which may have space available for fireworks stands. TNT will identify in writing to Albertsons on or before March 15th of each year this Master Agreement is in effect which Stores it would like to have fireworks stands in for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July holiday. TNT will identify in writing to Albertsons on or before October 31<sup>st</sup> of each year this Master Agreement is in effect which Stores it would like to have fireworks stands in for the New Year's Eve holiday. Upon the parties agreement on a list of Stores for each Company for fireworks stands, Albertsons shall prepare and the parties shall execute a Revocable License Agreement for each Company listing the agreed upon Stores for fireworks stands. TNT's right to install fireworks stands is limited to the Stores listed on the Revocable License Agreements. Albertsons may place, or may contract with any third party to place, any other fireworks stands on any Store not identified by TNT and listed on the agreed stores list by March 15th or October 31<sup>st</sup> as applicable.

#### 4 Payment for Fireworks Stands.

4.1 Fixed Payment. In consideration for having up to a total of ' (305) Events in each calendar year, TNT shall pay Albertsons the amounts set forth below on the dates set forth below to such payees, in such increments and to such lock boxes as Albertsons shall designate ("Fixed Payments"):

this Master Agreement may be disclosed for valid business purposes provided, however, that a party shall notify the other in writing at least ten (10) days prior to disclosure and confer with the other concerning means of maintaining the confidentiality of the terms of this Master Agreement. Prior to such disclosure, the disclosing party shall obtain the recipient's agreement to keep such information confidential

7.3 Survival. The confidentiality obligations set forth in this Section 7 shall survive the expiration or termination of this Master Agreement. When this Master Agreement is terminated or expires, each party's Confidential Information and any copies thereof shall be returned to that party except as may reasonably be required for the other party's records.

#### 8 Assignment

8.1 Assignment. TNT may not transfer, assign or sublicense this Master Agreement or any interest therein, and any such assignment shall be deemed null and void and of no force or effect. Nothing herein shall limit Albertsons ability to transfer, assign or sublease its interest in any or all of the Stores or this Master Agreement.

#### 9 Notices.

9.1 Notices. Any notice required or permitted by this Master Agreement to be provided to either party by the other party shall be in writing and signed by a duly authorized representative, and shall be deemed duly given (i) when personally delivered, (ii) when delivery is made or attempted on a business day by Federal Express or similar overnight delivery service, or (iii) three (3) business days after deposit in the United States mail, sent certified or registered mail return receipt requested, with first-class postage prepaid, (or any combination of the methods listed above), and addressed as follows:




