

## WEST LINN PLANNING DIRECTOR NOTICE OF FINAL DECISION FILE NO. MIS-21-03

On January 7, 2022, the West Linn Planning Manager approved a request to create a legal lot of record out of existing Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) right of way located northerly of the I-205 freeway, easterly of Salamo Road, and southerly of Barrington Heights. The purpose of the action is to facilitate the transfer of approximately 32.98 acres land from ODOT to the City of West Linn. No development is proposed as part of this application.

Alternatively, the Final Decision and Order, complete application, and all documents or evidence are available for inspection at City Hall at no cost. Copies may be obtained at a reasonable cost.

Persons who have established standing in this matter may appeal this decision to the West Linn City Council within 14 days of the Final Decision Notice mailing date pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 99 of the Community Development Code and any other applicable rules and statutes.

Appeals must be filed with the West Linn Community Development Department with the \$400 appeal fee by 5:00 pm. An appeal must include:

- The \$400 appeal fee;
- A reference to the decision (project number) to be appealed;
- The name, address, and signature of the appellant; and
- A statement explaining how the petitioner qualifies as a party of standing, as provided by CDC 99.140.
- The appeal application may state the grounds for appeal.
