WEST LINN HISTORIC REVIEW BOARD NOTICE OF FINAL DECISION FILE NO. DR-22-01 & SGN-22-04

At the April 19, 2022 meeting, the West Linn Historic Review Board held a public hearing to consider the request by Willamette Capital Investments, LLC to approve a Class II Design Review to make exterior changes to a historic resource (West Linn Saloon) located at 1731 Willamette Falls drive (Clackamas County Assessor's Map 31E02BA02500). The hearing was conducted pursuant to the provisions of CDC Chapter 99.

The Historic Review Board approved the application with six (6) conditions. The decision was based on the facts, findings, and conclusions found in the record.

The Final Decision and Order and application are posted on the City's website, <https://westlinnoregon.gov/planning/1731-willamette-falls-drive-class-ii-historic-design-review-exterior-alterations>. Alternatively, the Final Decision and Order, complete application, and all documents or evidence are available for inspection at City Hall at no cost. Copies may be obtained at a reasonable cost.

Historic Review Board decisions are final upon the date of the signature on the decision and effective 14 days from when the final, signed decision is mailed. If the fourteenth day falls on any legal holiday, Saturday, Sunday, or day that City Hall is closed, the effective date and time shall be at 5:00 p.m. on the next business day.

Persons who have established standing in this matter may appeal this decision to the West Linn City Council within 14 days of the Final Decision Notice mailing date pursuant to the provisions of CDC Chapter 99 and any other applicable rules and statutes.

Appeals must be filed with the West Linn Community Development Department with the \$400 appeal fee by 5:00 pm. An appeal must include:

- The \$400 appeal fee;
- A reference to the decision (project number) to be appealed;
- The name, address, and signature of the appellant; and
- A statement explaining how the petitioner qualifies as a party of standing, as provided by CDC 99.140.
- The appeal application may state the grounds for appeal.
