Subject: AP-23-01 Public Hearing Request

On March 13, 2023, City Council held a public hearing to hear an appeal (AP-23-01) of the approval of a Water Resource Area Permit (WAP-22-02) at 19679 Wildwood Drive. The applicant utilized the Community Development Code Chapter 32.070 Alternative Review Process to reduce the required Water Resource Area (WRS) buffer on their property.


At the public hearing, staff was asked by Councilor Baumgardner "has an application like this been applied for or approved previously in the City"? Planning Manager Darren Wyss stated "yes, I have been with the City a little over seven and one-half years and I've probably ran into a half-dozen or so of them". Both the Appellant and City Council requested staff to provide a list of previous alternative review applications.

Staff has completed the research and found six applications that utilized the alternative review process and were approved in the last seven years (see below). Three of the applications were approved by the Planning Commission and three were approved by the Planning Manager. Of note is WAP-19-02, in which the Planning Commission approved the reclassification of a stream to ephemeral and reduced the required buffer to 15 feet as part of a subdivision approval in 2019.
