1. Staff Reports:

Captain Ron Schwartz, West Linn Police Department

- Captain Schwartz advised the Tri-Met position rotated, and Officer Heimback is back on patrol and Officer Lesmeister is at Tri-Met.
- Three are in the Reserve Academy and will complete their academy in January.
- The police department's final recruit will be graduating from the police academy in November.

2. Old Business:

- Grant was at Oversight Committee Meeting and gave an update on the progress of the new police department.
- Dennis advised that he will be doing a presentation of Map my Neighborhood on Thursday with his neighborhood.

- Grant advised that a citizen contacted the police department and was referred to him. - Discussion took place to coordinate with the school district on disaster situations.

3. New Business

- Dennis Richey advised that he will be vacating the Chair position of the Public Safety Advisory Board. Thomas Freedland nominated Chuck Boman to be Chair, and Grant Oakes seconded the nomination. The nomination was unanimous and no one was opposed. Chuck will take the Chair position January 1, 2013.
- Dennis advised that Thomas Freedland has volunteered to be Vice-Chair. Dennis officially nominated Thomas Freedland for this position. It was seconded and the vote was unanimous and no opposition. Thomas will take the Vice-Chair position January 1, 2013.
- The committee reviewed the goals from the previous two years and compared them to the upcoming year.
- It was agreed that there will be a November meeting, and no December meeting for 2012.
- There will only be one drug-take-back in the Spring.
- Discussion took place regarding the website being updated and current. Bonnie Hirshberger had done some of the work on the website in the past.
