### Sergeant Neil Hennelly, West Linn Police

- Sergeant Hennelly advised that the police department has purchased trauma kits for officers' vehicles, and all officers will get advanced training on these trauma kits.
- Sergeant Hennelly advised that the police department has hired a lateral officer from Alabama, Ben Vice, and he will begin in June. He also advised that there are two laterals that are currently in the background process – one from Arizona and one from South Carolina.
- Sergeant Hennelly advised that the 789 Jam will be having their 5<sup>th</sup> anniversary.

### Piseth Pitch, TVF&R

- Piseth Pitch advised that he is currently looking at the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of August for the Emergency Preparedness Safety fair. He is still trying to get a location and confirmed date. He is looking at the LDS church or Willamette Christian. It comes down to cost of the location at this time.
- It was suggested that Piseth submits a budget to the advisory committee to present to Richard Seals for the fair for such things as refreshments, juice, cookies, etc. Possibly ask for \$500
- Lori Hall with the City is helping Piseth Pich with publicizing the fair

Grant and Denny advised that they had went to a City Council meeting and presented Map Your Neighborhood. A discussion with the group occurred in regards to the best way to put this on the website for citizens to gain interest and participate. Grant Oakes will be

Denny suggested trying to get together some volunteers together for Map Your Neighborhood. He said we could do the training of them. He thinks if we could build up a small number of volunteers that would be willing to go out once every two months or something to somebody's home and help them with what they need to do and lead the discussion, because that is the part that people don't want to do. Grant said they have also talked about maybe having a small seminar that we could offer regarding Map Your Neighborhood.

Chuck said he will appoint Denny as the Chair of this recruitment team. Denny said he plans on getting a hold of someone at the Tidings and work up a story about the needs still for preparedness and what we are trying to do to get the word out more. Chuck asked Arthur if he would like to volunteer to be a part of this. He advised that he would.
