CARE CENTER PATIENT MISSING AFTER TAKING WALK

On Sunday, April 6, 2008 at 6:53pm staff at the Roselinn Care Center, 2330 Debok Rd. West Linn, reported Paul Allen WALDREP a resident of the Adult Care Center missing.

Mr. WALDREP is described as a 64-year-old white male, 6'2" tall weighing about 180 pounds. He has green eyes and brown hair with some gray in it. He has an unknown tattoo on his upper right arm, and the tip of his middle finger on his right hand is missing. He was last seen wearing a red and white coat, blue jeans and brown boots.

Mr. WALDREP has conditions if left un-medicated would make it difficult to function.

In the past Mr. WALDREP wandered from a facility in Milwaukie and was located in Salem. According to staff at Roselinn he would likely approach people and ask for money or cigarettes.

His current whereabouts are unknown. If you see Mr. WALDREP please call your local police department.
