CALL TO ORDER AND INTRODUCTIONS

10th STREET AND WILLAMETTE FALLS DRIVE INTERSECTION TRAFFIC CONTROL STUDY

Wright mentioned that the Right-of-way person (Wayne Kwong) is being asked to make an assessment basically on what the property cost would be and with this study have the consultant come back with a low level planning estimate with what the cost would be for the three options (Traffic signal w/dual eastbound left turns; single lane roundabout; and a two-lane roundabout) including the pros and cons and costs, at that time we should be able to better evaluate the options after receiving this information.

Wright asked the members to review the study and email or send any concerns, comments, questions, etc. to him.

NEW BUSINESS

Yates asked if the footpath under Fields Bridge is open and if it is, could a sign be posted informing people that it is open. Wright will ask the Parks Director.

Alharithi asked if the COWL has anything in the long term to extend a bike or street car trail along Hwy 43.

Yates asked if there was a way to look at the pedestrian crosswalk located at the intersection of Broadway Street across Willamette Falls Drive. Yates suggested maybe reorienting the crosswalk. Wright will find out.

Gakstatter mentioned they are breaking ground for the new elementary school on Rosemont Road.
