Pedestrian Plan Improvement Project identified as:

- Map ID P55,
- Location West A Street
- Type: Sidewalk
- Project Description: Install sidewalks on the north side of the roadway from Terrace Drive to Skyline Drive
- Priority: High
- Cost (\$1,000): \$35 (2016)

The 2017-2018 development of two homes at 5685 and 5679 West A Street resulted in the construction of an approximately 115-foot long sidewalk along the east side of the roadway.

Icon Construction & Development's current eight townhome project on West A Street (5715-5745) will result in the establishment of a 200-foot long sidewalk along the roadway.

At present, sidewalks do not exist along the roadway from 5645 (at the crosswalk) to 5679 West A Street (apx. 120') and 5685 to 5715 West A Street (apx. 125').

Because of the discontinuous state of the sidewalk on the north side of West A Street between Skyline Drive and Terrace Drive, and due to the proximity to West Linn High School, I would suggest members of the Transportation Advisory Board consider Pedestrian Plan Improvement Project P55 of the 2016 TSP for a future Sidewalk Infill project (see attachment 'Screenshot 2024-03-24 142900 b.png' below).
