4. Business:

a. Highway 43 Vision Plan - Staff update

Staff gave the Board members an overview of the vision for the Hwy 43 corridor. The project should be about 2 years long. Staff said they are looking at the land uses adjacent the corridor as well as connectivity between neighborhoods adjacent to the corridor. Staff said they are reviewing city codes. Staff indicated they are working on community engagement and working with City Council and the Planning Commission. Staff said they

are doing a tax increment financing feasibility study starting in early 2025. Another big part of the project in 2025 will be a mixed-use zoning code, using a consultant to write a new zoning code for the City, which will incorporate the City's desires and needs.

b. Sidewalk Infill & Prioritization - Staff update

Matt Bell with Kittelson gave a presentation which includes how Kittelson went about prioritizing projects during the planning process. Kittelson hopes to have an initial draft of reprioritization projects to staff by the end of the year for review.

5. General Capital Project Update

10th Street project close out: Staff has a walk through tomorrow with a punch list. Landscape restoration will happen in fall.

Fields Bridge Park work is ongoing. There are now curbs and paving is happening. They are trying to get the sidewalk and bike path completed in a couple of weeks and have it paved the last week of September.

Cedaroak Safe Routes to School - Staff shared the work is almost complete. The sidewalk is done, and the stormwater planters are being worked on. Striping will be the first week of September.

Councilor Baumgardner noted the new TriMet bus line.
