#### 3. Business

#### a. Review of Arch Bridge Open House information

- Members that attended stated that some topics raised at the open house that were related to TAB goals is the need for connectivity for bikes and pedestrians including sidewalks.

# b. Review of Pathway Planning Map, staff recommended routes priority list, and possible recommendation for June Work Session and Council Agenda

- Lance provided overview of materials and how they are related to Trails Master Plan and Transportation System Plan. The members discussed the need to agree on the definition of "complete" with regards to on-street routes. Staff recommended priority tiers are based on information collected via the map displayed at the meeting which demonstrates how specific routes are connected to transit, commercial centers, school walking boundaries, connections to off-street trails and parks/open spaces. Routes located around multiple areas (transit, commercial centers, schools, etc.) were moved up higher on the tier system with regards to priority. Cost considerations haven't been identified yet. There were questions of whether Safe Routes to school should be focused on through the trails plan or the TSP. Lack of Consensus was identified by the group with regards to what factors should be considered most important for prioritizing routes. The board asked staff to provide more data on where gaps are located and the length of such gaps in sidewalks and/or bike lanes for future cost considerations. The board requested that staff provide a spreadsheet that shows all the different map layers and how they impact each route at next meeting.

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# 4. Staff Updates

- City will be considering SDC funding updates related to pedestrian and bike in the next year.
- Annual road program is out to bid and traffic signal project at Santa Anita/Rosemont/Salamo will be under construction this summer.
