Spill response program

EMERGENCY = Call 911

In the event of a hazardous material or waste release, fire, or emergency that is a danger to life, personnel health, or safety immediately call:

- 911;
- The West Linn Police Department if needed.

NON-EMERGENCY

Reportable Spills - Oregon Department of Environmental Quality categorizes reportable spills as:

- any amount of oil to waters for the state;
- oil spills on land in excess of 42 gallons;
- hazardous materials that are equal to, or greater than quantity listed in the Code of Federal Regulations, 40 CFR Part 302 (List of Hazardous Substances & Reportable Quantities), and amendments adopted before July 1, 2002;
- When it doubt, REPORT IT.

In the event of a non-emergency spill or release to water, soil, or air call:

- During work hours call the City of West Linn: 503-722-5500
- After Hours non-emergency number: **503-635-0238**

Be prepared to provide the following information when reporting a spill:

- location of the spill, an exact address or cross streets
- what material has been spilled
- estimated volume of material that spilled
- an initial assessment of the situation (have any drains been impacted, etc)
- how concentrated is the spilled material
- responsible party who spilled the material
- is anyone cleaning up the spill, if so, how
- Are there resource damages (e.g. dead fish or oiled birds)? Contact information of person reporting the spill (name and phone number)
