DESCRIPTION OF WORK (Give street cut length, if applicable)

This permit is issued for construction within the City of West Linn's (City) public right-of-way as described upon the attached plans. All construction shall conform to the City's public works construction standards, the approved construction drawings and any on-site revisions required by the City of West Linn.

ATTENTION: Oregon law requires you to follow rules adopted by the Oregon Utility Notification Center. Those rules are set forth in OAR 952-001-0010 through OAR 952-001-0090. You may obtain copies of the rules by calling the center. (Note: the telephone number for the Oregon Utility Notification Center is (503) 232-1987). Locate requests shall be made 48 hours prior to any work taking place.

This permit is issued subject to the following conditions:

- 1) Applicant acknowledges that the City's sole function is to review the plans and inspect the work to assure compliance with the City standards and specifications. The City assumes no responsibility of any kind for the accuracy or suitability of the work submitted.
- 2) Applicant assumes responsibility for compliance with all laws, ordinances, regulations, codes and other rules which apply to the construction for which this permit is issued.
- 3) Applicant shall inform contractors, subcontractors and other persons performing work for which this permit is issued, of the provisions of the City's public works construction standards and assure their compliance with those provisions.
- 4) Applicant shall allow access by City employees or its representatives to the property where construction is being performed for inspections or other duties connected with the public works construction for which this permit is issued.
- 5) This permit shall be void if work is not completed within six months of permit issuance.
- 6) Other special conditions which apply are: **No street cuts are permitted without an addendum. Restore any disturbed areas within the R/W. Comply with erosion control measures as required by current City of West Linn codes and the current Clackamas County Department of Utilities: Erosion Prevention and Sediment Control Plans Technical Guidance Handbook.**

I have read the foregoing conditions under which this permit is issued and do hereby agree to comply with those conditions and any additional conditions of approval following processing of the permit.
