LOCATION OF PROBLEM: The section of Landis Street that begins at the intersection with Stonegate Lane and travels south		
around the bend is particularly narrow as there are no shoulders. When cars park along both sides of the street		
it reduces traffic to one lane. Many children are present in the neighborhood and the blind curve makes the situation signifantly dangerous.		
REQUEST: Paint yellow (NO PARKING) along the East curbline where Stonegate Lane and Landis Street intersect.		
Continue South with the painted curbline until the sidewalk begins at the lamp pole. This section of curb is along a		
natural stone retaining wall.		
REASON REQUESTEDThe familes in this area are in fear that either one of their children or fellow resident will be struck		
by cars attempting to navigate the chokepoint. Preventing cars from parking along this side of the street is felt to be		
a reasonable step toward ensuring the safety of those in the neighborhood.
