REQUEST: Make all of South side of Burns St a NO PARKING ZONE between Hood St and Cascade St

REASON REQUESTED With the addition of a sidewalk and parking spaces on the North side of Burns St for the completion of the Perkins Law project, and the historic parking allowed on the South side of Burns St for the Grief Therapy sessions at side entrance to 5695 Hood St, there is absolutely no possibility of simultaneous East/West traffic on Burns St. With cars parked on both sides and two opposing cars trying to pass - one or the other has to back up!

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS: It was thought obvious that there would be no parking on the South Side of Burns St when the Perkins Law building project was approved. Yet the City has done nothing to paint curb yellow, nor remove the "No Parking Here To Corner" and replace it with a NO PARKING sign..
