REQUEST: Replace static 20MPH sign with digital sign that displays speed limit & vehicle approach speed

REASON REQUESTED Currently & historically this is a problematic intersection where drivers do not slow down to the posts 20MPH limit. I know this because I see it daily, met with this committee on the topic in the past, and periodically the speed tracking trailer is parked here.

We all know it's a problem and yet the city seems indifferent to solving the issue with a modern sign / approach.

It's time to resolve this issue. The opening of the food carts has only added to the problem as more cars parking

along this section of WFD and side streets further limit visibility of pedestrians and cars entering WFD from side streets.
ADDITIONAL COMMENTS:

The speed trailer parked at the limit sign does seem to help. If you do swap to a more modern sign/solution

Relocating the sign another 50ft West would allow for vehicles from 16th st to turn onto WFD more safely
