LOCATION OF PROBLEM: Crosswalk on Santa Anita Drive at intersection of Horton Road and Churchill Downs Drive.

REQUEST: Add flashing lights at the location. Existing crossing flags have proven to be ineffective.

REASON REQUESTED We have had numerous issues of automobiles speeding in both directions on Santa Anita Drive.

Aggressive drivers are unaware of people in the crosswalk until near-miss accidents have occurred. Having lived on the corner for twenty years I have heard and witnessed not only car collisions, but many near misses with pedestrians. I walk through this intersection every day. Standing on the corner waiting for it to be safe to cross, half the cars go flying by without stopping.

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS: We have reported this to the Haverhill Homeowners Association, and they have acknowledged that other neighbors have also had issues. With an elementary school nearby and the crossing at the apex of the hill, it should be addressed (when the school was built I contacted the school district regarding this and got no where.)
