REQUEST: Traffic calming measures. Honestly, I don't really care what they are, and I'm not a civic engineer, so I'm open to suggestions. Some potential solutions are a stop sign at Imperial Drive and Rockridge Drive, traffic circles divided lanes, narrow the road, adding bike lines next to the curb and parking outside the bike lanes.

REASON REQUESTED People speed through the neighborhood where children are often playing, putting kids and vehicles at risk. Speeds likely upwards of 40 MPH. I've been passed by faster cars on the road and seen other cars get passed as well. People are using the residential road as an arterial. I just want them to slow down. The WLPD has erected speed signs, with no noticeable effect.

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS: I'm really open to all kinds of solutions. I just want the neighborhood to be a safer place for the kids. We have quite a lot of them on who live on the street. There's not a lot of traffic, but I'd like what is there to be going slow enough that the kids are likely to survive an impact.
