this would also help slow down people speeding down the hill (which is often icy at this area coming to the steep hill)			
It would also remind people on South Hillcrest to stop before turning left, since Marylhurst Dr westbound has right-away there.			
REASON REQUESTED Being new to the area, it gave me fresh perspective at this intersection. Both my wife and I have struggled with not			
being ablt to safely view the intersection, or to properly do so means inching forward enough to where we are almost half-way			
into the intersection. That combined with some speeding cars coming from S. hillcrest has given us room for pause,			
but we worry for others who are new to the area as well.			
ADDITIONAL COMMENTS: I realize that the property near the intersection	on with the stone wall and h	edge may be a part of the problem,	
but in a car that is low to the ground, it seems that while trimming/taking out shrubs may help, I don't believe it would			
completely give full visualization of the intersection, but I wouldn't mind if the property was notified as well.
