LOCATION OF PROBLEM: Bluegrass Way street

REQUEST: I am requesting the addition of speed humps with pavement markings on Bluegrass Way as a traffic calming method.

Ideally, a hump near the intersection of Bluegrass Way and Carriage Way, and another near the intersection of

Bluegrass Circle and Bluegrass Way should calm driving speeds on the street.

REASON REQUESTED The statutory speed of 25 mph is too high for the terrain of Bluegrass Way, which is both hilly and curvy.

There are residences on both sides positioned relatively close to the road, and properties are beautified with flora that

limits the distance of visibility on the curves. There are many walkers, runners, pets, and children using the sidewalks at all hours.

Cars traveling = or > than 25 mph don't have adequate time to react to emergencies. Backing out of one's driveway is a highly cautious event!

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS: Bluegrass Way appears to be used as a pass-through for many vehicles traveling

between Carriage Way and Hidden Springs roads. Consequently, Bluegrass Way is a high-traffic, noisy street.

This reduces the desirable peace & quiet (and property values) of this lovely West Linn neighborhood street.
