LOCATION OF PROBLEM: Parker Road. Specifically the 35 mph stretch between Salamo and the bend of Parker and Summer Run.

REQUEST: Speed reduced from 35mph to 25 mph. Additionally I would like to request the school zone be extended to match that of Salamo and Rosemont Rd during the same hours.

REASON REQUESTED This stretch of road is surrounded by several high-traffic community destinations, including the parks, Rosemont, Safeway, tons of neighborhood streets and trails. Because there is no bus service here and its proximity to above mentioned spaces, there is a constant flow of children and individuals crossing and traveling this area.

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS: Currently, the speed limit of 35 mph is frequently exceeded, with many drivers traveling at 45mph or higher. This creates a dangerous environment for pedestrians (kids!!), cyclists, and families that regularly use the area.
