LOCATION OF PROBLEM: South side of Cedar Oak Dr. between Willamette Dr. and Old River Rd.
alongside the parking lot and ingress/egress to Emmanuel Presbyterian Church and Tri-Met park and ride.

REQUEST: We request that a NO PARKING strip is painted and signage moved 30 feet east along the south side of Cedar Oak Dr. between Willamette Dr.
and the entrance to Emmanuel Presbyterian. This would extend the current "No Parking" section 30 feet east.

REASON REQUESTED There is currently parking allowed on the south side of Cedar Oak Dr. at the above-mentioned location,
and it creates a serious visibility hazard for those trying to exit the church and the park and ride lot. Cedar Oak Dr. is a
major neighborhood arterial road for Robinwood neighborhood and CedarOak Elementary and carries a heavy load of traffic for a residential road.
Our completed request would greatly improve visibility and avoid accidents occurring from those trying to egress from the parking lot and those driving on Cedar Oak Dr.

and how our request would greatly improve the vehicular safety of those using this road.
