Meeting of the Robinwood Neighborhood Association(RNA) called to order at 7pm.

**Agenda** approved.

**Guest Speakers:** MYN Dennis Richey - MYN applies to initial 90 minutes after an event, however we need to prepare for months of self-sufficiency. Public Works Director Lance Calvert - Prioritizing repairs: Transportation Advisory Board should have geographic diversity. Pavement Management Report by 3rd party consultant presented to TAB. Ratings 0-100 by condition with improvement costs attached. Deferred maintenance due to budget constraints. Many existing streets not constructed to current cross section standards. Heavy vehicles like construction and trash trucks do most of the damage. Balance between preserving with slurry seal and reconstruction. Water system condition with old cement, galvanized and cast iron mains constrains reconstruction. Clustering projects saves money moving equipment around the city. Hwy 43 and I-205 owned and maintained by ODOT. Insufficient taxes to pay for increased costs. Application for federal STIP funds to rebuild 43 from LO to Hidden Springs is \$4 million with 25% by city. STIP grant funds for entire ODOT Region 1 covering Metro area for 2019-2021 is \$11 million. Hwy 43 Conceptual Design Plan Update. Separating bikes and peds from auto traffic. Additional cost of cycle track is minimal compared to total cost of administration, design and standard highway cross-section construction. TSP review at PC and Council driving the schedule for Hwy 43 update.
