18000 Upper Midhill Dr. Development update by Atty David Noren and Developer Ron Zygar. 34 units on R4.5 zoning minimum density per city code. Anticipate some form of payment to city to mitigate traffic at Arbor and 43, to comply with new Hwy 43 Conceptual Design Plan. Additional material submitted to city. Application not yet deemed complete but expected within a week. Mayor Axelrod and Councilor Perry recused themselves from this presentation.

LOT Emergency Response Planning: Lt. Stradley and Blaine Keane - City not joining JTTF due to no net gain. Local contacts for any threat to any water source. LOT required to have emergency documentation (350 pages) per federal regulation. Working on WL's response plan. Emergency information on Twitter and Facebook plus landline phones only. Police will respond to all calls. Prepare for potential. Response training for neighbors forthcoming.

Hwy 43 Update: Lance Calvert & Kevin Bryck - Information available under Hot Topics banner at top of city main page. This plan will be an addendum to new 2016 TSP and will go through a hearing process at the Planning Commission and the City Council. LOT will be paying to repair the drain at Mapleton at Hwy 43. Plan will need many details worked out with ODOT, Trimet and other agencies prior to construction, including bus turnouts and widening of West Linn residential streets to allow for right and left turn lanes. City not striping residential streets.
