Meeting of the Robinwood Neighborhood Association(RNA) called to order at 7:04pm, agenda approved. New guest: Kevin Bryck is back in the neighborhood.

Guest Speaker:

- a) Talk with a Constable (WLPD rep): Last week there were several car break-in's (cars were unlocked) on Wilderness Dr. At 3am, police saw a car turn without signaling and found out the driver had a warrant and stolen goods were found in the car. The word on the street is that WL citizens have valuables in their car and criminals come here to steal.
- b) Bob Martin, WL City Councilor: He had a goal of changing the cultural of city hall (staff replacement new city manager, new community development director, assistant to the city manager promoted from within and the cost is less than it was several years). They came up with a reasonable budget without raising fees, but they don't have much of a reserve right now. In two years, there will be a big PERS payout required. A Park bond will be paid off in a few years. Code has changed so that advisory boards advise the council rather than staff like they did before. Robinwood CUP is a top priority for the council.
