Pre-application meeting is scheduled for 8/17/17 at 9:00am for the proposed removal of the existing home on 4120 Mapleton Drive and partitioning the lot into 2 parcels.

Updates:

Robinwood Station: Randall Fastabend: Meeting with Planning Commission on 8/16/17 at 6:30pm to consider changing the code to waive the CUP process for Robinwood Station. The City Council will meet on 10/9/17 to vote on the code change. The wifi was not provided within 3 weeks so Cummings and Sakelik's offer of pizza party would be appreciated. President O'Toole will follow up on the wifi issue with Shane Boyle. The RNA Picnic is set for 8/26/17 from 12-4 and the Repair Fair is 9/23/17 from 10:00am to 1:00pm.

Community Garden: Lisa Clifton: The Garden is spectacular. Help is needed so anyone interested in joining the Garden, please contact Lisa.

Committee and Community Reports:

Parks and Rec: Don Kingsborough: SOLV work party at Mary Young park on 8/5/17 had 24 hard working volunteers. Volunteer participation is growing. The bridge over Mary creek washed out. No City funds are available to address this right now.

Old Business:

1) 18000 Upper Midhill Development update: Some citizens filed an appeal with LUBA. The developer has joined the City to defend their decision.

2) 43/McVey Traffic Revision update: President O'Toole sent a letter to ODOT (Rian Windschiemer manager of Region 1) relating to neighbors concerns about traffic delays caused by the revision. Jenne Henderson reported that this change was made to have a dedicated left turn lane for safety reasons. Neighbors have seen traffic back up to Walmart and many are using alternate routes to avoid excessive delays.

New Business:

1) Next Door Robinwood: some neighbors received a post card to join. This is a local social media site designed to share information with neighbors, such as local notifications (e.g., missing pets), events, concerns, services, etc. The City and County and send out alerts as well.

2) Kenthorpe Paving meeting: rescheduled to 8/23/17, 6:00pm at Robinwood Station.

3) RNA Picnic Table: The Robinwood Garden received a donation of 24 salvaged 8' mahogany deck boards. Kevin Bryck proposed the purchase of a picnic table frame that can be topped with the mahogany (tabletop and benches).

4) RNA Sign Improvements: The signs will be inventoried and we will discuss updating the signs at the next meeting.
