A question was raised if there is a way to post lower speeds on Nixon, Mapleton – 20 or 15Mph? It was decided the best approach is to have multiple individuals reach out to the City and Traffic Safety Committee with their concerns.

Randall commented that he made a trip out to Cedar Island and was surprised how clean it was, virtually no garbage at all.
