DJM Development Mountain View Court Presentation: By Mountain View Court is accessed via Skye Parkway and abuts the RNA above Hillside Court. There are 2 R-10 parcels, comprising 8.2 acres, one vacant and the other with one home. Proposed Planned Unit Development for 17 homes on R-7 lots with Low Impact Development Approach (see on Clean Water Services website). Each home covers own runoff. Engineer is Atwell. Trying to save 80% of trees.

Hwy 43 Intersection Changes: Discussion of pending changes at Hwy 43, Cedar oak and Hidden Springs. Committee presented to City Council on 12/12 and hope to make a more thorough presentation to place a hold on the current project until we have a more inclusive plan, including outreach to commercial property owners and business owners.
