City did not update the TSP in 2020 as required. Neighborhood wants a process where we go back to safety goals and look at all potential solutions including speed limit and numerous commercial driveways instead of only promoting the one solution.

Olie Olsen presented his maps showing a 5 lane Hwy 43 alternative with bicycles along MS Young frontage path and Old River Rd.
