ROBINWOOD NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION MINUTES February 13th 2024 Meeting

Meeting Called to Order by Tony Bracco at 7:00 pm. Agenda approved by acclamation.

Safe Routes to School sidewalk on the Cedaroak Drive - Luke Borland & Jameson Lumpkin presentation: This project chosen because it is considered the highest priority and best use of the funds in the city. \$1.5 million funding is entirely from 2018 GO Bond fund. No grant funds, but a demonstration for future Safe Routes grant requests by city. No outside agencies involved in the design, however must comply with federal ADA standards.

Plan is currently at 90% stage, goal for project completion summer 2024 while school not in session. Curbs and street trees should serve as traffic calming to lower speeds.

All new storm swales and trees to be maintained by the city. All surface drainage to Trillium Creek. Vehicle traffic lanes to be maintained at current width of about 14 feet (standard is 12 foot minimum).

Discussion of an asphalt path versus concrete sidewalk, federal ADA standards, durability and the pending proposes changes to Robinwood Vision regarding pedestrian amenity cross-sections in the Transportation System Plan.

Second phase of Recreation Center citizen polling coming up.
