

# ROBINWOOD NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION MINUTES

## July 9th 2024 Meeting

**Meeting Called to Order** by Jim O'Toole at 7:06 pm. Agenda approved by acclamation.

**Guests and new attendees:** None

**Luke Borland, City of West Linn - Cedaroak Safe Sidewalks update:**

Contract won by D&D, a contractor specializing in Safe Routes sidewalks.

Flashing beacon at Trillium included in project to east of intersection.

Work on one side of road, flagging traffic, no full closures, working progressively along project.

Project starting at Trillium where most work is. Project to be completed before school begins.

Planned work hours 7am-4pm weekdays only. Could use a trailered red light versus 2 flaggers.

Jim O'Toole talked about lack of positive response to neighborhood suggestions, especially regarding use of grade level path instead of curb and gutter sidewalk configuration.

Calaroga Pump Station project to begin in August.

Ole Olsen presented letter by Sharon Treadgold and spoke about the sidewalk project: Will ruin the character of neighborhood with industrial look and the failure of outreach with lack of notice when he was not home. Noted lack of respect by city staff during discussions.

Further discussion ensued regarding history of lack of city response to neighborhood concerns.

**City Council report by Carol Bryck:** Boat parking 12 month trial for 24 hour trailer parking with follow up study. Restricted to streets wide enough for safe passage. Rec Center lacks support to go to voters for bond this November and city will look for private partnership.

**May and June Minutes:** Motion by Eric Nepom, second by Carol Bryck, Approved by acclamation.

**Treasurer's Report:** Balance is \$4376.91 No expenditures.
