Meeting of the Robinwood Neighborhood Association (RNA) called to order at 7:05 pm.

Rich Fiala - Stafford Hamlet Development Update:

Hamlet formed by county in 2006. 25 year fight to preserve rural area. Undesignated land cannot be brought into UGB until 75% of 50 year urban reserve supply is brought in. Urban Reserve designation successfully appealed by WL and Tualatin and remanded. Compromise for Borland to be Urban Reserve area approx. 200 acres, double of Kruse Way and remainder north of Tualatin River to be undesignated with up-zone for EFU parcels. New developer plan for 6700 new residential units on top of Borland.
